We anticipate action from 10th December but could be any time.

Please familiarise yourself with attached images of the drill rigs that will be travelling down from Queensland, and report immediately if you see one, take photos if you can, and follow it to see where it goes. The company that Metgasco has contracted is AJ Lucas, keep an eye out for any vehicles with the company logo, which is also attached.
