

SAVE BLACK ROCKS KOALAS!

A petition addressed to Cr Longland asking him to revegetate Black Rocks sports field and enclave the entire area for the koalas (along with a rescission motion on the Men's Shed and removing the koala protection gates) amassed almost 34,000 signatures from all around the world (over 73 countries). Cr Longland has the balance of power in council and was voted in on an environmental platform and has been quoted by the media 'I am keen to protect the koalas and have them thrive'. Yet he has voted against koala protection at Black Rocks sports field in recent years. In the last 2 years 7 Black Rocks koalas have died from stress-related chlamydia or unknown causes. Council has failed to regulate koala-impactive human activities. This simply can't go on!



Lucia, a juvenile, was captured with symptoms of chlamydia, taken into care, healed and released back to the same tree earlier this month. Her mother would also have chlamydia and needs to be captured for treatment. Unless the sports field is revegetated there is no hope for Lucia.
