

World's Largest lock-on -sydney

A total of more than 200 people came from all over NSW, including The Northern Rivers, Gloucester and the Pillaga region. About 100 of these locked onto the fence and gates. No one was arrested and the demonstration ended peacefully.

Scott Sledge, President of the Northern Rivers Guardians, delivered to the office of the Police Minister, Troy Grant, a petition with more than 1000 signatures from the Northern Rivers asking for the news laws not to be implemented.
