I had a long meeting with Tweed MP yesterday and we discussed (among other things) the Casino - Mur'bah Rail corridor. He thinks it is silly to close the Casino to Bentley section, but has been assured that "many people want it." I suggested these would be real estate developers, but he assured me that the ALP amendment has guaranteed that the land must remain public and can't be sold or otherwise disposed of without a complete new Act of Parliament, which is what protects the Rail corridor now. He continues to pursue the link from Queensland to Tweed Heads and is proud of the additional busses in his coastal electorate.

He agreed it would be good to have a rail link between Mullum and Byron Bay.

That's the main things. Any questions?

I wrote to many MLCs to support an Inquiry as we still need to stop the tracks being removed, right?
