Forest victories? The Forestry Corporation have removed Myrtle and Bungabbee State Forests from their planning portal. Myrtle is now shown as completed (the roading is) and Bungabbee has evaporated. Our focus of attention on them has been effective in getting them to back down - well done all. It just goes to show that if we make enough fuss (and threaten mass action) we can get them to back down (at least temporarily).

Doubleduke is still in the firing line, roading starting in March though logging appears to have been put back to the end of the year (December), Camira which is just across the road from Myrtle has a roading plan (Roading started in November 2020?), and Gibberagee a logging plan (October).

Our successes at Myrtle and Bungabbee comes with a cost, they are now planning logging (August) in Cherry Tree State Forest on the Richmond Range and in Richmond Range SF (June) (a new purchase near Peacock Creek), and additional logging in Ewingar. There is plenty of logging further out.

So if anyone wants to do some scouting there are plenty of options.
