Tweed Shire Councillors and the Council have been deciding on whether or not to rip up the rails when they form the rail trail.

Initially they said they would ask for tenders to construct the trail with the rails or without. Not sure whether they did or not.

Although the final decision has not been made they seem to be pushing for cycle trail only. This to me is another example of the lack of consideration they give to Murwillumbah and its business community.
