## **OUTSTANDING BUSINESS:**

- 1. <u>Injunction against NSW State Government</u>: Another party is pursuing an injunction. Because WCRT is not a legal entity it must remain at 'arm's length'. Jahman suggested approaching Al Oshlack, Nimbin to ascertain if he could assist us.
- 2. Adjacent land owners Survey: held over.
- 3. NSW Government Letter Campaign: Toni will compile information and contact details for tiers of government.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

- 12. <u>Potential Entrepeneurs as Sponsors</u>: It was suggested we research and approach entrepeneurs in the region who may be interested in establishing a light rail commuter service. Tom noted that there are a lot of people who work in Mullum but can no longer afford to rent in Byron. Regular commuters could fund the service, which could then transport tourists to Destination Murbah. Current funding for school buses etc could be diverted to the commuter service. It was noted that due to lack of public transport
- 13. <u>TSC Rail Trail contract</u>: It is highly likely that government would extend the funding deadline if project is not completed before March? 2022. As it is a Design and Construct project there are many tasks eg safety management, which must be completed before construction can commence.
