Re: Proposed Changes to the Kyogle Local Environment Plan (KLEP)

Dear Kyogle Council...

I ask you to defer a decision on any changes to the KLEP until after the September elections to avoid an impression of a rushed decision while many in the community are uncertain about the details and the implications. I wonder what it is all about and would like more information, and I know others who are in the same position.

The Kyogle region includes some of the world's most diverse biology and we should make preserving our World Heritage listings a priority. Wildlife conservation leads to long term prosperity. The future is too precious to waste with decisions that may undermine our best efforts at ecology. You have a duty to adequately inform the public and give people time to submit comments, and that does not seem to have occurred on this important decision. Thanks for extending the public input period by two weeks, but you should probably give people more time to submit comments.
